BRYANT POND STATION, 18 Loon Court, Bryant Pond, ME, house phone # 207-665-2455

Please be sure to call during the week prior to your arrival to discuss keys and go over any last minute items.

Please don't forget to bring towels and we also recommend flashlights just in case of a power outage.

Directions from the south

Take the Maine turnpike north to exit 63 (Grey).

Stay on Route 26 north the whole way. It is a little over 1 hour from the exit to the house.

You will pass through towns such as Mechanic Falls, Poland, Oxford (you will see Wal-mart on the left), Norway (Super Hannaford's shop 'n Save supermarket on the right),

South Paris (you will cross the railroad tracks). Then you will pass through West Paris where you will cross route 219 and there is a Mobil station on the left and Perham's Maine jewelry store is on the right. We highly recommend you check out Perham's and their museum at some point. This part of Maine is famous for Tourmaline crystals.

You are now about 15 minutes from the house.

As you approach Bryant pond, you will see route 232 diverge to the right

(STAY ON 26!).

You then descend a long, steep hill. At the bottom, 26 curves sharply to the right. You then pass "Breaus too" store on the left. Make note of this store. Quick access from the house and they have a good breakfast and serve pizza, subs, ice cream etc. If you look just beyond the store you will see

our "Bryant Pond station" house over by the lake.

Take the next left which is Pine Point road, CAREFULLY cross the railroad tracks, then turn left

onto Loon court. Drive through the paved parking lot and into our gravel parking lot at the

end. The "Bryant pond station" sign is on the brick wall of the house.

The station phone has a block on it so calling card must be used.

The caretaker is George Fraser. His number is 665-2383. He lives 5 minutes away.

It is very important to follow the departure instructions located above the thermostat on the left side of the french doors between the kitchen and the "map"room

**From the  
Manchester airport:**



From the Manchester airport take rte 93 north.  
You will pass through Concord, Tilton, New Hampton, Plymouth, Woodstock, Lincoln.  
North of Lincoln rte 3 will join.  
Near Cannon mountain, rte 3 diverges, take rte 3.  
Eventually you will cross rte 302.  
STAY ON 3 and in Carroll, take rte 115.  
Rte 115 joins rte 2 in Jefferson highlands.  
Take rte 2 east. You should get some great views of the White mountains along this stretch.  
Take rte 2 through Gorham, Shelburne, Gilead and into Bethel, Maine.  
Bethel is 15 minutes from the Bryant pond house.  
Take rte 26 south.

In 10 minutes you will pass through the small hamlet of Locke mills.  
You will then pass a lake on your left followed in a few miles by a baseball field on your right.  
When you see the speed limit sign for 30 MPH you will then start down a small hill and the railroad will come along beside you on the right.

Take the next right onto Pine point road, cross the railroad tracks and turn left onto Loon court.  
You will drive through the Condo parking lot and into our parking lot.

The blue and white Bryant pond station sign is on the façade of the house.
